Morning Presentations...

Dr. David Yang is the Provincial Practice Leader in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery for the BC Cancer Agency, and lectures for the GPR Program and Prosthodontic Residents at VGH and UBC. He received his DDS from the University of Toronto before entering a General Practice Residency at New York Presbyterian Hospital - Cornell Medical Center, and the Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center. He then completed a residency there in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery where he received advanced training in anesthesia, oral pathology, orthognathic surgery, TMD joint disorders, facial trauma and dental implants. Dr. Yang is in specialty practice with Drs. K. Chow and J. Choi, and is co-founder of the Vancouver Broadway ITI Implant Study Club.



David's presentation will discuss post-cancer changes to the oral cavity and how they impact our ability to treatment plan and render dental care in private practice.

Dr. Ali M. Sadeghi earned his DMD at UBC before completing his medical degree and an Oral & Maxillofacial Residency at Mount Sinai Medical Centre in New York City. Dr. Sadeghi practices the full scope of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery as a certified specialist in all areas of the profession, including management of maxillofacial trauma, advanced implantology and facial rejuvenation.



Dr. Sadeghi and Prosthodontist Dr. Kevin AminZadeh will present in tandem this morning, focusing on bone grafting and bone reconstructive techniques.



Dr. Kevin AminZadeh obtained his DDS at the University of Western Ontario in 2001, following which he practiced general dentistry in Vancouver for 10 years prior to receiving his MSc in Prosthodontics from the University of Michigan. Dr. AminZadeh is an expert in digital laboratory workflow and utilizes an on-site digital laboratory in his office. He is also an avid proponent

of the operating microscope. He excels in implant treatment planning and placement. Kevin is a fellow of the Royal College of Dentists of Canada and a clinical assistant professor at UBC.

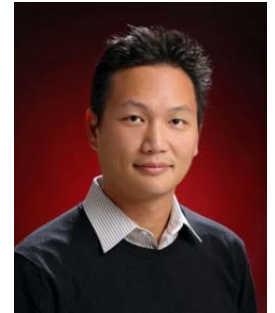

Afternoon Presentation...

Dr. Ben Kang obtained his DMD from UBC, and practiced general dentistry for two years before completing his Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery Residency Program at Lincoln Medical Center of Cornell University in New York City. He was invited to assume an attending physician position at the same hospital where he dedicated his time to training residents. Dr. Kang was also appointed to a faculty position at *Weil Cornell Medical College* as an instructor in clinical surgery. He is a fellow of the Royal College of Dentists and a diplomat of the American Board of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeons. With his previous general dentistry background, Dr. Kang embraces the collaboration with referring colleagues in all phases of patient care.



Dr. Ray Grewal and Dr. Ben Kang will present in tandem this afternoon, addressing the identification and management of intra-operative and post-operative complications associated with office based oral surgical procedures.

Dr. Raymon Grewal received his BSc from McGill prior to earning his DDS at Columbia University in New York City. He later obtained his specialty degree in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at Yale University. Upon the completion of his residency in 2005, Dr. Grewal joined a respected specialty group in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, where he practiced for four years before returning to Vancouver. He is currently an Assistant Clinical Professor at UBC, and



an attending surgeon at both BC Children's and Lion's Gate Hospitals. Dr. Grewal also serves on the Board of the BCDA and of the Dental Specialists' Society of BC. He practices the full scope of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery with a special interest in dentoalveolar procedures, anesthesia, implants, bone grafting, oral pathology, facial reconstruction and trauma.
