Brief Award Descriptions

Wildcat Pride Awards

Developed by students in 1998, the Wildcat Pride Awards recognize students for three characteristics that best represent leadership values at K-State Salina: Dedication, Determination and Community Service. Three Wildcat Pride Awards (one for each characteristic) will be presented during the awards ceremony.

Most Inspirational Student Award

A student who radiates inspiration is recognized by this award! This person has gone “above and beyond” and truly worked hard to inspire other students through his or her life example and experiences.

Outstanding Organization Award

The Outstanding Organization Award was created to recognize an officially recognized on-campus organization that has been active in a variety of activities.
