### <u>Side by Side's Public Service Externship Program - June 2015</u>

#### **STUDENT OVERVIEW:**

Side by Side's Public Service Externship Program is designed to provide 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students with an opportunity to gain practical public service experience as part of high school education. An externship is a method of experienced-based learning that focuses on giving students practical work experience, simply by pairing a Berkeley Carroll (BC) student with a BC parent willing to mentor and/or allow the student to shadow them in their professional work environment.

### **Benefits for Student Participants:**

- Exposure to meaningful work and volunteer opportunities in the field of public service
- Improved understanding of the nonprofit and government sectors
- Gain a sense of connection and motivation to continue to volunteer in our community
- Learn and develop new interests and career-related skills
- Opportunity to reflect on and identify professional goals
- Strengthen oral and social interaction skills

<u>Work and Credit Requirements</u> -- It is assumed that BC students will be available Monday through Friday from 9:00am to 5:00pm and will be provided with a one-hour break for lunch daily. Students will not be paid, nor would they be provided a transportation stipend. The BC Parent Association will subsidize travel expenses for students that require and request financial assistance. All students and employers will be required to complete a one-page questionnaire upon the completion of each externship. Feedback will help guide program improvements for subsequent years.

Student Eligibility & Placement - Externships are available to exiting 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grade students for the week of June 15-19, 2015 and they will be required to complete an application which will request the student's top three individual placement choices. Students will also be asked to list their past volunteer experience and complete three brief essay questions. Applications that are incomplete and/or not approved by a parent/guardian will not be given consideration. Applications are due by March 11, 2015 and will be reviewed by a volunteer, parent-led Public Service Externship committee and the school administration. Placements will be limited by the number of BC Parent Field Supervisor placements. Student selection will be based on the quality of applications and the Committee's ability to make the best student matches with the field placements available. Not all applicants will be guaranteed an externship placement.
