TOURNAMENT RULES AND INFORMATION

Check www.tournamentasa.com for all tournament updates.

- * Game time is forfeit time.
- * Forfeits can only be called by the UIC or Tournament Director.
- * **All teams must be ASA registered for 2015 and have certificate of insurance**

General Rules (using A.S.A. Code)

- Metal cleats may be worn.
- The Tournament Director & Umpire-In-Chief reserve the right to change the tournament format in the event of inclement weather. This includes game time & time limit changes.
- A team may use players outside of its roster if it is determined they would have to forfeit due to a shortage of players. Teams may not use players to make their teams stronger.
- Pool Play: Teams have the option of batting all of the players present at the game or a legal ASA lineup. (Nine or DP/Flex). If batting all of the players, teams may use the first previous batter in the line-up that is not on base for a pitcher or catcher as a courtesy runner. If nine, then all ASA courtesy runner rules apply.
- Prior to each game: A lineup must be presented to the umpires.
- Pool play will not have run rules.
- Pool play will have a limit of 5 maximum runs per inning.
- There will be a 75-minute time limit on all games, including championships.
- Pitching distances: 43 feet for all divisions.
- Teams registered as "A" may enter one division higher than they normally play. Teams registered as "B" must compete in their age division.
 - Ex. 16A may play 18 OPEN
 - 16B must play 16A
- Pool games can end in a tie. **No records will be kept for pool play.**

The gate fee will be: Adults - \$5 Youth 6-17 & Senior Citizens - \$3 Children under 6 – Free

Our goal is for everyone to have an enjoyable tournament weekend. An emphasis will be placed on proper conduct by coaches, players, parents and spectators. Anyone acting inappropriately in the judgment of a game official or tournament director will be subject to removal from the park and/or elimination from the tournament.

Please no food or drink may be brought into the park. No pets are allowed in the park.

POOL PLAY & SINGLE-ELIMINATION TOURNAMENT RULES

POOL PLAY:

Pool Game 1 – Runner at 3rd base – no outs

Pool Game 2 – Runners at 1st and 2nd base – no outs with 1-1 count on all batters

Pool Game 3 – Runner at 2nd – no outs

- 1) In the first inning, runners are the last 1, 2 or 3 players listed on the team's lineup. Coaches have the option of skipping pitchers or catchers.
- 2) After the first inning, runners are the last 1, 2 or 3 batters preceding the leadoff batter. Coaches have the option of skipping any pitchers or catchers.
- 3) Pool Play: Teams have the option of batting all of the players present at the game or a legal ASA lineup. (Nine or DP/Flex). If batting all of the players, teams may use the first previous batter in the line up that is not on base for a pitcher or catcher as a courtesy runner. If nine, then all ASA courtesy runner rules apply.
- 4) No Run Rules in Pool Play
- 5) Teams will play for 75 minutes
- 6) Drop Dead Time Limit applies to all pool games
- 7) Five runs/inning max – offense goes on defense
- 8) Pool games can end in a tie. **NO RECORDS will be kept in pool play.**

SINGLE ELIMINATION TOURNAMENT

- 1) All teams will play in the single elimination tournament.
- 2) All batters will start with a 1-1 count.
- 3) All teams will bat legal ASA lineup. Nine or DP/Flex.
- 4) All ASA run-rules will apply: 15 after 3, 12 after 4 and 8 after 5.
- 5) Time Limit: 1 hour 15 minutes, finish the inning.
- 6) After 7 innings, or if the time limit has expired, the international tie-breaker takes effect.
