What teaching strategies does your school use to target student engagement? The seminar introduces participants to adult learner motivation. Dean will present best teaching instructional techniques which will address:

- Lessons (which have) clear achievable aims and short-term objectives.
- A variety of activities including practical work, activity-based learning, and the positive use of life experiences (yours and students).
- Your teachers (setting) high expectations and teaching adults to think for themselves and work independently, putting an emphasis on career training.
- Questioning (which is) quick-fire, lively and gets all involved.
- Humor- used to good effect and to relieve tension.
- Utilizing feedback (focusing) on how work could be improved by specific steps.

Participants will receive handouts describing various teaching techniques, worksheets for designing classroom lessons, and a module based approach to assist school instructors to be more engaging and effective within the classroom.
