- Your teachers (setting) high expectations and teaching adults to think for themselves and work independently, putting an emphasis on career training.
- Questioning (which is) quick-fire, lively and gets all involved.
- Humor- used to good effect and to relieve tension.
- Utilizing feedback (focusing) on how work could be improved by specific steps.

Participants will receive handouts describing various teaching techniques, worksheets for designing classroom lessons, and a module based approach to assist school instructors to be more engaging and effective within the classroom.
