David Behrman is CEO of Behrman House Publishers, the leading publisher of textbooks, software, and other educational materials for Jewish religious schools throughout North America. Behrman House has over 600 titles in print, and has published such notable authors as Mordecai Kaplan, Milton Steinberg, Meyer Levin, and Eugene Borowitz. The firm has pioneered use of digital language instruction and digital tools in the religious school environment, having published its first digital title 11 years ago. Behrman House recently launched its Online Learning Center, the community's first cloud-based education portal, which allows for blended learning in the classroom and the home.

Before joining Behrman House, David Behrman was a consultant with McKinsey & Co, in New York, where he served Fortune 500 clients in the manufacturing, service, and transportation sectors, and several major not-for-profit institutions. Before that he practiced corporate and securities law with Davis Polk & Wardwell in New York. Behrman graduated from Haverford College with a B.A. in economics and holds a J.D. from Stanford Law School, where he was a member of the Law Review. He has been admitted to the Bar in New York and in California. He serves on the Boards of Israel21c, a U.S.- and Israel-based online news magazine covering 21st-century Israel, JVillage Networks, a Vermont-based developer of websites and engagement vehicles for congregations throughout North America, Luminary Digital Media, a start-up which develops socially-networked content and collaborative tools for the secondary and higher education markets, and The Partnership for Jewish Learning and Life. Behrman has also served on the Executive Committees of the Little Red School House/Elisabeth Irwin High School in New York City, and of Temple Sinai in Summit NJ.
