





How to make your Morning Edition  
**GUIDE BOOK MARK**




You'll be making an accordion-style guide that you can use as a bookmark. The process is a little like folding a business letter.

1 PRINT this DOCUMENT.




**TIP** Printing DOUBLE-SIDED will make a better guide.



(But single-sided will also work for this project - just start step 2 with the printed sides up.)

2 FOLD the edge FARTHEST from the dotted line to the dotted line.




3 FLIP your paper over.



4 FOLD the other edge to the already folded edge.



(5) REPEAT (4) you have two single-sided pages. After you do, you can tuck them inside one another.
