

#### MY ID WAS STOLEN! NOW WHAT?

Whether the breach is minor or major, immediately do the following:

a/ Contact Equifax, Experian, or Transunion, and place an initial fraud alert on your account. That requires credit card companies to verify your ID, often by contacting you directly, before issuing credit in your name. The alert is free and lasts for 90 days.

b/ If you find criminal activity, send a certified letter to the bureaus and whatever company issued the phony credit (e.g., a department store's fraud department, if the store's credit card was opened in your name). Keep records of your communication.

c/ Create an identity theft report. It will help wipe bogus accounts from your credit report and stop companies from collecting debts resulting from the activity. The theft report consists of two parts: an affidavit you fill out and submit to ftc.gov/complaint and a police report (take a copy of the FTC form and any other proof of the theft, such as credit reports, to the police station).

d/ Send the report to the credit bureaus and any business or institution that issued false credit, with a request to clear the fraudulent accounts from your file. Credit agencies are legally bound to do so within four business days. In addition, filing an ID theft report lets you place an extended fraud alert on your credit file that lasts for seven years and requires banks and credit card companies to contact you for verification if a credit request is made (the alert also entitles you to two free annual credit reports from each bureau).

#### "PARKING SMART" IN 2015

Police Departments are asking residents to reduce crime in 2015 by following "Park Smart". Take your keys, secure your valuables, and lock your vehicle. An overwhelming amount of vehicle thefts and vehicle burglaries are due to unsecured vehicles and by owners leaving valuables in plain sight. Thefts from vehicles is one of the most easily prevented crimes. It only takes a few seconds for a thief to open an unlocked door and grab whatever is visible.

These crimes tend to occur during the overnight hours where thieves often remove hundreds of dollars' worth of valuables in seconds. Thieves simply help themselves to items such as purses, wallets, cell phones, computers, iPad/Pods, and GPS system that were left in plain sight. Along with "Park Smart", residents may find the following procedures helpful while parking out in the community or at your residence:

a/ Lock your doors.

b/ Take your keys.

c/ Don't leave valuables in your car.

d/ Take all valuables with you or place them in your trunk, if possible, before reaching your destination.

e/ Never leave a vehicle running and unattended. It's not only dangerous but it's against the law.

f/ Do not leave your garage door opener inside the vehicle.

Don't be afraid of being wrong about whether or not someone has a legitimate purpose for being in the community. If you see anyone acting suspicious, looking into cars, or trying door handles, please do not hesitate to call the police. Call police even for a gut feeling or a hunch. Be a good witness, and let the police investigate further.
