INSPECTOR GENERAL QUATREVAUX SHARES REPORT DETAILS WITH COMMUNITY GROUPS

Inspector General Ed Quatrevaux was a guest speaker at community meetings hours after his office released New Orleans Police performance reports. On May 14, Quatrevaux addressed the Faubourg Lafitte Tenants Association Monthly Meeting and told them about the findings of his audit of NOPD forcible rape reporting to the FBI's Uniform Crime Report.

"The biggest problem in New Orleans is public safety," Quatrevaux said. "Good police departments keep good records, and ours hasn't been doing it."

On May 28, following the release of OIG's evaluation of NOPD staffing and deployment, Quatrevaux talked about the report with about 30 members of NEW CITY Neighborhood Partnership. He also answered questions about the OIG's goals and priorities.

Quatrevaux hosted high school seniors participating in "Boss for a Day," a job shadowing experience featuring tours of offices in the criminal justice system. In June, Quatrevaux addressed Loyola University students enrolled in the political science summer session class "Corruption in American Politics."
