Eco Explorers II: 1st Grade

Tuesday, April 28 (3:30-5pm); Tuesday, May 5 (3:30-5pm); Tuesday, May 12 (3:30-5pm); Tuesday, May 19 (3:30-5pm)

Members of this session will explore the out of doors with our Venture Out staff. Students will explore Canterbury's natural environments and learn essentials of environmental stewardship.
