# Do Your Homework and Prepare in Advance

- Research colleges of interest. Before visiting, become familiar with academic programs, extracurricular clubs, athletic teams, campus events occurring during your visit, etc.
- Schedule appointments with faculty, coaches, college staff and include these meetings in your visits in addition to admission office tours, information sessions, and college interviews (when available).
- Review college admission websites for information about tours and information sessions, as well as suggestions for local lodging and dining options.

## What to Expect in College Admissions

- Participate in a campus tour (advance registration may be needed)
  Wear comfortable shoes and be prepared for the weather.
  Tours take place rain or shine and last 1-1.5 hours.
- Attend an information session and take notes.
  Arrive early. Seating may be limited.
- Schedule an interview if available.
  Prepare questions in advance.



# **Get to Know the Campus Community**

- Eat on campus. Prospective students should go to a meal with a current student if possible.
- Read student publications, such as a campus newspaper.
- Visit campus facilities of interest: the athletic center, student center, library, dormitory, places of worship, etc.
- Inquire about campus safety and crime statistics.
- Tour the surrounding area.



## **Recording College Visits**

- Take pictures during your campus visit. They will help you to remember your college tour more clearly.
- Record your thoughts about the college visit. Include both positive and negative aspects. Document any meetings with faculty, coaches, etc. Take the time to write thorough and detailed notes; they will come in handy when developing your college list and writing supplemental essays.
