NOMINATION OF MINISTER COMMISSIONERS

- 1. The Nominating Committee shall place before the presbytery at its January meeting the names of two people, one to be elected Commissioner and one as Alternate to the General Assembly meeting that same year.
- 2. These nominees shall be persons who are presently Continuing Members of Muskingum Valley Presbytery and meet the following criteria:
 - a. Have been members of Presbytery at least four years.
 - b. Have not attended General Assembly as a commissioner in the last ten years.
 - c. Are actively involved in the life of Presbytery. (Retired and Non-Parish pastors are eligible.)
 - d. Those seeking nomination are to submit a completed application form, with Session acknowledgement (parish pastors only) to the chair of the Nominating Committee. This time is not to be considered continuing education or vacation time.
 - e. The Presbytery Committee on Representation may, if it deems appropriate, encourage particular ministers to submit nominations.
- 3. Alternates will be selected as carefully as principals. Unless activated as alternates they may be given preference the following year, but must apply again.

NOMINATION OF ELDER COMMISSIONERS

- 1. The nominating committee shall place before the Presbytery at its December meeting the names of two persons, one to be elected Commissioner and one as Alternate to the General Assembly meeting that same year.
 - a. Any church which has not sent an Elder Commissioner to General Assembly in the last five years may nominate one person.
 - b. The nominee will be actively involved in the life of Presbytery and the local congregation.
 - c. The application form, with Session endorsement, must be completed by the applicant and returned to the chair of the Nominating Committee of Presbytery.
 - d. The Presbytery Committee on Representation may, if it deems appropriate, encourage particular congregations to submit nominations.
- 2. Alternates will be selected as carefully as principals. Unless activated as Commissioner, they may apply again.

GUIDELINES FOR NOMINATING YOUTH ADVISORY DELEGATES TO GENERAL ASSEMBLY THE PRESBYTERY OF MUSKINGUM VALLEY

These guidelines are developed on the basis of the following principles as related to General Assembly:

- It is the highest governing body of the Presbyterian Church.
- It is a significant educational and spiritual event.
- It is a legislative and polity setting body.
- It must be concerned with the broad spectrum of the "whole" church.

Therefore, it is imperative that those persons elected to serve as Commissioners have:

- A prayerful openness to the leading of God's Spirit.
- A reflective and flexible attitude toward issues.
- An understanding of the Church's mission.
- A reasonably informed understanding of the Church's mission.
- The responsibility to hold open the dates of General Assembly until after the assembly has convened.
- A willingness to do much reading prior to and during General Assembly.
- The physical health to sustain them for long hours.
- A willingness to share the experience and information gained with the presbytery following the event.
- A willingness and ability to participate in the committee process.

The selection of Nominees for General Assembly will include the following considerations:

- Active involvement in the life of the presbytery and/or the local congregation.
- Competencies, abilities and interests related to current issues which will be discussed.
- Sensitivity to inclusive participation with regard to age, sex, presbytery geography, size of home church, and ethnic identity.

NOMINATING PROCEDURES

- The Nominating Committee of Presbytery shall solicit applications for Young Adult Advisory Delegate nominees by sending a letter to pastors and clerk of sessions.
- 2. The nominee shall be between 17 and 23 years of age on the date the Assembly convenes and must be endorsed by her/his Session. No church shall submit more than one nominee.
- The application, with Session endorsement, must be completed by the applicant and returned to the Chair of the Nominating Committee.
- 4. Ordinarily the Nominating Committee will plan to interview candidates in November.
- 5. Nominations will be submitted at the December meeting.
- 6. The following criteria shall be considered:
 - a. Leadership ability and involvement in the local church.
 - b. Communication skills and ability to share their faith.
 - c. Ability to function actively in committee process.
 - d. Involvement in community and school activities.
