CAMPS FOR OLDER CHILDREN

Trailblazers & Trailblazers Extreme • Ages 11-15

Once again campers will explore state parks, hike up and down mountains, cool off in rivers, lakes and waterfalls, while learning survival skills that apply to outdoors and practical life situations. Trailblazers Extreme (TBX) is more strenuous than the Trailblazer version. TBX features faster and longer hikes and involves adventures into more difficult terrain further away. It is important that TBX campers are prepared physically and have the necessary equipment. Campers will be hiking substantial mileage each day. Cancellation Policy: Our cancellation and refund policies are based on our investment in staff, program activities and supplies before our summer program begins. The \$50.00 deposit is non-refundable. If you cancel your child's registration after May 15th, you will be responsible for 50% of the camp fee. Upon the first day of camp, you will be responsible for payment in full, even if your child does not attend camp, except in the case of a student's serious illness or injury (with documentation by physician) or the death of an immediate family member. Students who leave during the summer session for one of these reasons will receive a pro-rated refund (less the non-refundable deposit). To request a refund, you must submit a letter to the Finance Office outlining the reasons for cancellation and provide appropriate documentation within 30 days of your cancellation.
