

Bass Lake Mini-Vacation

June 4-7, 2015

Experience a relaxing long weekend at a beautiful mountain camp where all ages are welcome, delicious meals are provided, there are no meetings, no chores and no instructions—except to have fun! At 3,400 feet above sea level, Skylake Yosemite Camp sits among the pines with its own private Bass Lake waterfront. Located near Oakhurst, the camp is approximate a 4 hour drive from Palo Alto.

You're encouraged to arrive on Thursday afternoon at/after 4pm. Feel free to bring a picnic supper, or dine at a local restaurant.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Rustic screened cabins sleep up to eight people—each cabin has four bunk beds. A single bed and mattress is provided for each camper. You bring your own sleeping bag or linens. Bathhouses have sinks, showers, toilets, electricity and lights, but cabins do not. Weather is typically warm in the daytime, but temperatures can dip to 50 degrees in the evening. Dress is very casual.

FOOD AND DRINK

Eight delicious meals are included in your registration fee, beginning with breakfast on Friday morning. Most lunches and dinners include a salad bar, and vegetarian options are available at every meal. You can pack a sack lunch if you will be out of camp at lunchtime. The camp is unable to accommodate special diets, so you will need to provide for food allergies or other dietary needs.

On Friday and Saturday evenings immediately before dinner is Social Hour on the outdoor deck of the main hall. Appetizers are served by the camp staff and augmented by the campers, who bring snacks and beverages to share.

ACTIVITIES

Select your own activities at your own pace—hike, swim, canoe, water ski, kayak, do arts and crafts, archery, read, snooze, play volleyball, basketball, tennis or tether ball. One horseback ride is included with your registration (ages 6 and up). Water skiing and boat rides are available for an extra fee. The south end of Yosemite Park is approximately 45 minutes away.

In the evenings the camp offers a campfire program, including marshmallows roasted over the coals. Bring songs, jokes and poetry to share. Back in the main hall, we play cards or other games, read, knit, work on jigsaw puzzles, play ping pong or foosball. Some venture down to the dock to stargaze.

FEES & REGISTRATION

The fee includes three nights of lodging, eight meals and one horseback ride for ages 6 and up.

- For cabins with three or more people, the fee is per person.
- For cabins with two or fewer persons (1 or 2 adults, 1 adult and 1 child, or 1 adult and 1 baby), the fee is the minimum cabin fee.

The first week of registration is reserved for UUCPA members and friends.

UUCPA-ONLY registration is March 1st-March 8th.

Following the UUCPA-only registration period, priority will be given to prior attendees and UUs from other congregations.

If you register between March 1st and April 1st:

Age 13 and up:	\$245
Age 6 to 12:	\$165
5 and younger	free
Minimum cabin fee:	\$515

If you register between April 2nd and May 31st:

Age 13 and up:	\$260
Age 6 to 12:	\$175
5 and younger	free
Minimum cabin fee:	\$550

Reservations are secured based upon receipt of completed forms and payment in

the UUCPA office. Cabin assignments are made on the basis of last year's placement whenever possible, unless requested otherwise. If you are willing to share a cabin, please indicate this on the registration form. Two same sex cabins (1 women-only & 1 men-only) may be available if there is sufficient demand.

"Camperships": If you or your family has a financial need, there are funds available to help offset the cost of registration. Please discuss your need with either Parish Minister Amy Zucker Morgenstern or Associate Minister of Religious Education Dan Harper.

Refund Policy: You may apply for a full refund until April 1st and a half refund between April 2nd and May 31st. Refunds for medical reasons, or other extenuating circumstances, may be discussed with the Camp Registrar.

Cabin assignments, a what-to-pack list and additional camp information will be sent via email on or before May 28th.
