Payment may be remitted by company check or personal check; however, NO personal checks will be accepted within 21 days of departure date. All checks are payable to: Great Events. Credit cards are subject to a 4% handling fee.

## CANCELLATION POLICY

**Space is limited** - we have accommodations for up to 72 people.

**Suite or Hotel?** We have 12 - 2BR/2Bath Suites at Delta Whistler Village Suites and 12 - 2Q/1K Rooms at Listel Hotel Whistler. We will reserve rooms in the order requests are received.

**CVOA Membership** - Required for 2015 and 2016. Membership covers the calendar year.

**CVOA Funds** - your \$100pp reservation fee to CVOA will be used in part to cover group expenses such as bus driver gratuities and a dinner for the group on one night at Whistler.

**Passport** - Required for travel to and from Canada.

**Trip Insurance is recommended**, and you can purchase it through TravelGuard, using their link on the Great Events & Escapes website, when you make your initial deposit to GE&E. We will have more information about travel insurance in August; you can expect to pay at least \$125pp for basic travel insurance. You can use other travel insurance companies, as well.

### **Travel to Boston or Montreal:**

You are responsible for getting yourself to your airport. For Logan, we will not be chartering a C&J bus (Portsmouth to Logan) for the group, although C&J does have regularly scheduled buses at most hours. There are group rates available. The parking is free at C&J.

### **Montreal or Boston?**

Both Airports are 3.5 - 4 hours from Sugarloaf.

Advantages of flying out of Montreal:

- Non-stop flight, 3.5 hours shorter trip
- Easy Customs process at US-Canada Border, vs. airport luggage transfer
- Park-Sleep-Fly somewhat less expensive, and only one night stay for most.
- Fewer opportunities for flight delays and luggage loss/delay

We have 28 seats on Air Canada from Montreal and 44 seats on United from Boston. Seats will be filled in the order requests are received.

### **Checked Baggage Fees**

- United: First Checked Bag is \$25, Second Checked Bag is \$35.
- Air Canada: First and Second Checked Bags are \$28 each.
- United accepts one ski/pole bag and one boot bag as one piece of checked luggage.
- Air Canada accepts "one or more" ski/pole per bag.
- Refer to [united.com](http://united.com) and [aircanada.com](http://aircanada.com) for more details.
- If you do not have experience traveling with ski equipment, ask someone who does.

**Transfer between Vancouver Airport and Whistler** - This is included in the package. It is a scenic 2-hour ride. If you choose to do your own air and transfer (deduct \$465), keep in mind that your own r.t. transfer Vancouver - Whistler can be \$125 and up.

**Groceries** - We will not be stopping at a grocery and liquor store on the way to Whistler, but the Whistler Marketplace IGA grocery store and BCLiquor Store are within walking or shuttle distance from our accommodations.

**Whistler/Blackcomb Lift Tickets:** Full access to both mountains for 5 of 6 days; for 6<sup>th</sup> day, add \$50; Senior (65+) lift tickets: 5-day, deduct \$30 OR 6-day, add \$10

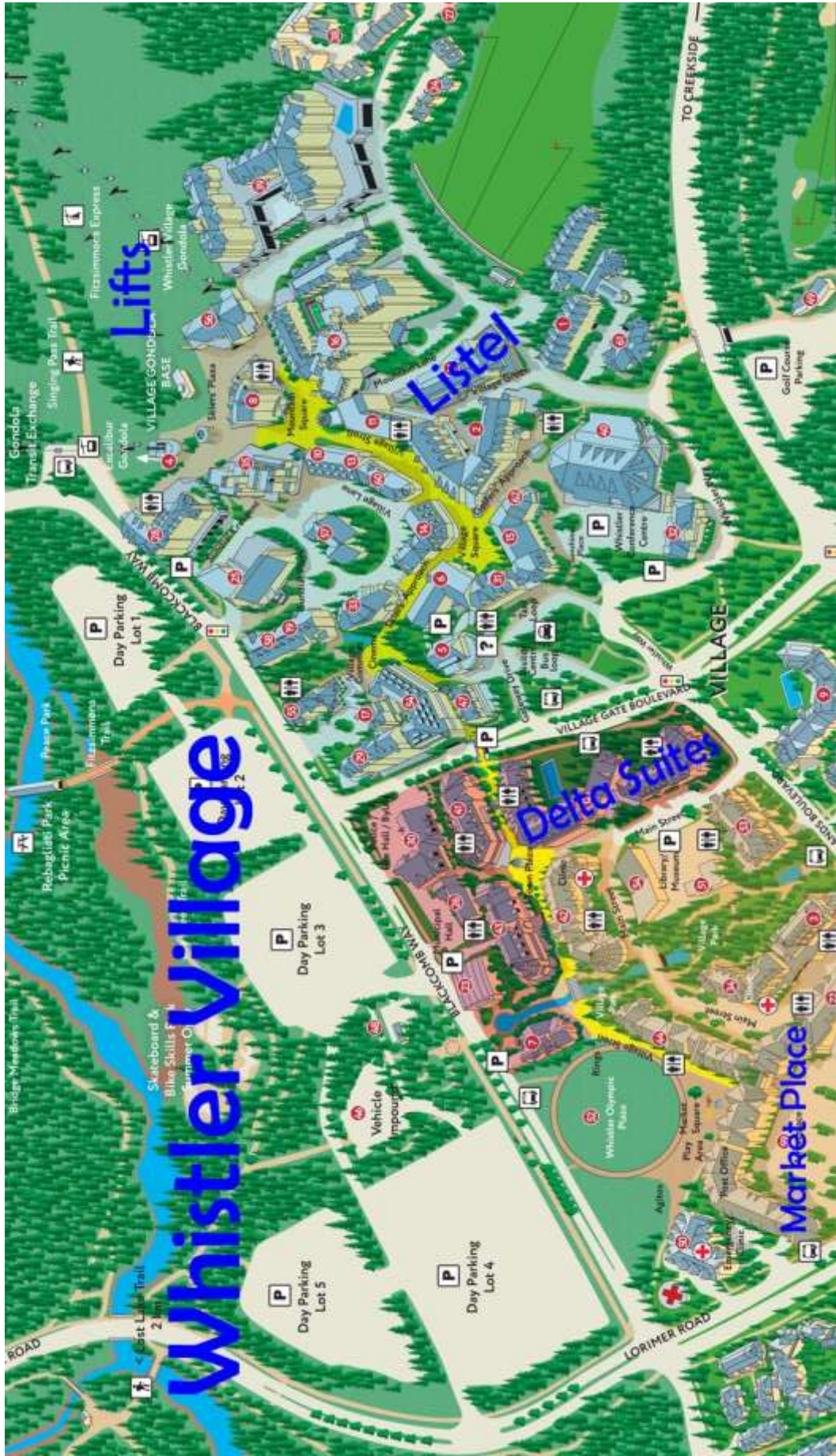
