



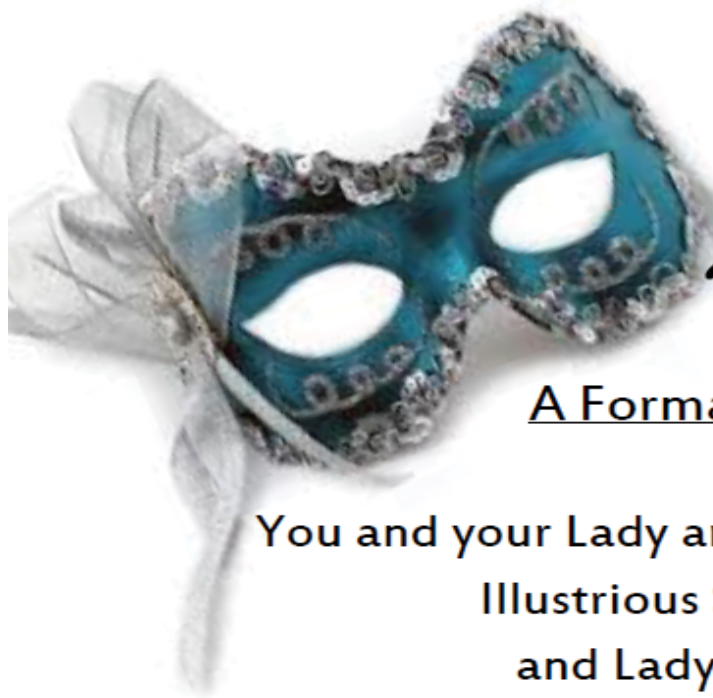

ORIENTAL GUIDE

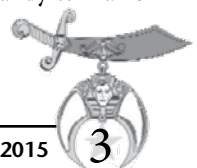

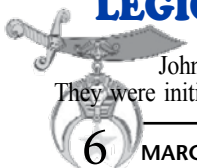
