Scholarship Program Guidelines

The Chuck Wiercinski Scholarship for the Illinois CCIM Chapter was created to support qualified real estate professionals in their efforts to achieve the CCIM designation. Recipient should exemplify the high caliber of professionals that comprise the CCIM Institute.

Scholarship Selection Criteria

Includes the following:

- Each applicant should be able to demonstrate a commitment to a commercial real estate career (see application).
- Each applicant should be able to demonstrate active involvement as a dues paying member with the Illinois CCIM chapter (see application).

For those seeking advanced course scholarships (CI 103 or CI 104) this additional criteria applies:

- Recipient of this scholarship should be selected from among individuals who have already successfully completed CI 101 and CI 102 and are currently Candidate Members of the CCIM Institute and have a need for financial assistance.

Scholarship Value

Recipient will receive a full institute member tuition enrollment in **one** of the following CCIM designation courses during the 2015 year: **CI 101, CI 102, CI 103 or CI 104.**

NOTE: The Illinois chapter will reimburse a candidate upon completion of their passed course.

Procedure

Applications are submitted directly to the Illinois CCIM Chapter by email to mike.mallon@dkmallonre.com

NOTE: The course selected can only be taken in 2015. The scholarship can not be applied retroactively to any course already taken; the award is not redeemable for cash; the chapter will not reimburse individuals for any courses already taken.

Deadline for Submission to Chapters

February 28, 2015.

Recipient Notification

Letters will be sent on or before March 15, 2015, notifying those selected. Once accepted, and the course is completed and passed, submit proof of completion to the chapter for reimbursement. Recipient is responsible for making his/her own travel arrangements.
