

Public Hearing #1

Make your voice heard! On March 15th a public hearing will be held on adopting the 2015 International Building Code with amendments, the result will be the eventual issuance of the 2015 Michigan Building Code.

The proposed rules provide the latest standards to protect the health and promote the safety and welfare of the people by regulating the construction, reconstruction, and alteration of buildings within the state. Adoption of the 2015 edition of the IBC as well as an update of the rules could result in cost savings for homeowners and contractors who will be able to use the latest materials and technology as a result of the revisions. Perhaps there is a code requirement that you would like to see re-examined, or perhaps there is a section that you feel is not strict enough. Whatever the case, if you'd like to have a say in how the codes are adopted and enforced, this is your opportunity.

The hearing will also cover proposed updates to the Michigan Rehabilitation code for existing buildings as well as the state mechanical and plumbing code.
