Wee Farmers - Ages 18 months - 3 years

Campers experience nature, animals, and basic farming <u>alongside</u> parents/guardians. 9:30 - 11:30 AM - \$155 per week or \$290 for one, two week session.

Pea Pods - Ages 4 and 5

Learn about the plants and animals that make up our local landscape. Basic lessons and artistic explorations help campers discover the wonders of nature, gardening and how to feed and care for farm animals.

8:45 AM - 11:45 AM - \$185 per week or \$350 for one, two week session.

Farm Hands - Entering K-2

Explore the farm, its animals and ecosystems through farm-based activities including games, art and nature through dynamic "hands-on" adventures.

8:45 AM - 3:30 PM - \$235 per week or \$450 for one, two week session.

Growing Farmers - Entering grades 3-5

Campers will experience the farm through team building activities, arts, and games. Children will also play a role in caring for the farm and learning the responsibilities of the animals.

8:45 AM - 3:30 PM - \$235 per week or \$450 for one, two week session.

CFS Explorers - Entering grades 6-8

Campers will explore farm habitats, learn about organic gardening, activities also include cooking, fort building, and looking for endangered species. Camp overnight is included in each session. \$240 per week or \$460 for one, two week session.

Montessori Experience - Ages 10-13

Campers will open their learning experience to the farm using the multi-dimensional concepts from the Montessori philosophy. Children will solve new challenges by caring for animals, tending crops, and meeting the community service goal of Gifts of Love and the Simsbury Community Farm. Offered for two-week sessions.
