

Sunday 26th July to Saturday 1st August 2015 Robinson College, University of Cambridge

The Hymn Society of Great Britain and Ireland is delighted to be hosting the 2015 international gathering of Hymn Societies in Cambridge next summer. This will be the third time we have met in Great Britain and previous Conferences in York (1997) and Oxford (1981) were memorable occasions.

Robinson College, our Conference venue, is the most modern of the colleges having been founded in 1979. It has fine facilities and the chapel, one of the largest in Cambridge, has two outstanding stained glass windows by John Piper. It also boasts a world renowned Frobenius organ.

The Conference begins on Sunday 26th July and ends on Saturday 1st August. For those unable to stay for the whole time, shorter booking options are available. Our keynote lecturers, drawn from the four participating societies, will reflect on the overall Conference theme: *Hymns in Liturgy and Life*.

Each day will begin with worship in Robinson College Chapel. A regular pattern of lectures, presentations and sectionals will follow. All papers will be available in English and in German with skilled translators on hand to enable plenary sessions and question times to run smoothly. Hymn Festivals will form an important part of the programme and we will be holding these in local churches and colleges.

Cambridge is located in East Anglia some 60 miles north of London from where it is easily accessed by rail and road. London Stansted airport with its excellent network of routes to European cities is only 30 minutes away by train. The city is home to the thirty-one colleges which comprise the University of Cambridge. The historical centre of Cambridge including the majestic chapel of Kings College is in comfortable walking distance of the College. A guided walking tour of the major sites will be included in the programme. We are also including an excursion to Ely Cathedral.

Accommodation at Robinson College is in comfortable single, en-suite study bedrooms. Free internet connections are available. More details can be found on the college website: www.robinson.cam.ac.uk
