(this form is to only be used for Individual Adults or for Adults on behalf of Minors)

IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to participate in any way in Beach Cities Cycling Club, Inc & South Bay Bicycling Coalition (enter name of LAB Club) ("Club") sponsored Bicycling Activities ("Activity") I, for myself, my personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin:

- 1. ACKNOWLEDGE, agree, and represent that I understand the nature of Bicycling Activities and that I am qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such Activity. I further acknowledge that the Activity will be conducted over public roads and facilities open to the public during the Activity and upon which the hazards of traveling are to be expected. I further agree and warrant that if, at any time, I believe conditions to be unsafe, I will immediately discontinue further participation in the Activity.
- 2. FULLY UNDERSTAND that (a) BICYCLING ACTIVITIES INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS OF SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING PERMANENT DISABILITY, PARALYSIS AND DEATH ("Risks"); (b) these Risks and dangers may be caused by my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the Activity, the conditions in which the Activity takes place, or THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASÉES" NAMED BELOW; (c) there may be OTHER RISKS AND SOCIAL AND ECONÓMIC LOSSES either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS, AND DAMAGES I may incur as a result of my participation in the Activity.

Compressed Air Rocket Template

(Cut on the solid lines and fold on the dashed lines)

Build your rocket at home:

- 1. Cut out the Body Tube and 4 fins
- 2. Fold fins along dotted line.
- 3. Wrap body tube around ½" PVC pipe to ensure it fits the ½" PVC launcher.
- 4. Fold over top of body tube and tape closed. This forms the tip of the rocket.
- 5. Attach fins with tape.
- 6. Wrap rocket with tape. This reinforces the paper to withstand the force of the launch.
- 7. Decorate your rocket.
- 8. Bring your rocket to Summer Camp Expo 9AM-1PM on March 14th at MBMS
