



Rules & Regulations

- Each team will consist of a maximum of 10 people
- Registration is online (graysonumc.org) and each team will be responsible for \$150 at time of registration and t-shirt sizes for each participant.
- \$100 will go to save 10 lives and \$50 for shirt cost
- We will have food available starting at 12pm on Sunday, March 15th. We will have concession stand with food, snacks, and drinks for purchase and all proceeds will go towards No More Malaria. Bring money and eat lunch at the church.
- Tournament will begin at 1pm
- 16 team soft limit—may add more if able
- Teams will be placed into 4 team pools and play in a Round Robin format
- Each team will be guaranteed 3 games
- After the Round Robin is over, the top two teams from each pool will be placed into a tournament bracket
- Games will be 5 minutes long or until one team loses all of their players
 - Win will get you 3 pts
 - Tie will get you 1 pt
 - Lose will get you 0 pt
- Once the tournament begins:
 - Games will be 8 minutes long
 - Final will be 10 minutes
- 5th Grade and up will be welcome to play
 - 4th grade and below will register through Katie and we will have a couple of games between the adult games.
- Teams will start with 6 players on court and 4 on the bench
 - Once a player is out, he/she will not be able to re-enter the game, and the next person off the bench enters
 - Once everyone from the team is out, the other team wins
- Ways you get out:
 - You get hit with the ball before it has hit the ground
 - Once the ball hits the ground once, it is a neutral ball
 - A ball that you throw gets caught by the opposing team before it hits the ground
- **All hits must be shoulder or below. No HEADSHOTS**
