



Japonica Campus Roof Campaign

WHAT?

Plans are underway to begin replacing / repairing roofs on the Japonica Campus.

WHERE?

The immediate need is to replace the roof on Inge Hall. This building currently houses our Pre-K4 and Kindergarten classrooms along with our computer lab for the elementary grades.

WHEN?

Now! Our campaign to raise funds is already underway for this project and will allow us to provide a new roof on Inge Hall while the students are out for Spring Break and before we embark on the rainy season.

WHY?

As we expanded our mission to include an upper school campus during a time when the economy was waning, certain maintenance needs were deferred. It is now time to raise the funds for the roofs on Japonica.

HOW?

Once the existing roof is removed, the supporting structure will be evaluated. The plan calls for a new commercial grade TPO roof system. If the supporting structure needs repair or replacement it will be addressed as well. That could potentially cost an additional \$15,000 - \$30,000.

HOW MUCH?

The goal is to raise \$100,000 in addition to the funds that have already been secured. Currently, a few parents have already contributed \$27,500. That amount coupled with the goal of \$100,000 should provide the amount needed to replace the roof and supporting structure. Any additional funds will be used for other roof repair projects on the Japonica Campus.

WHO?

You! With the help of our current and former families, our alumni and grandparents, as well as our friends in the community, we will soon have a new roof on Inge Hall
