WHO IS YOUR DETROIT REGIONAL CHAPTER?

Formed in Fall 2002, the Detroit Regional Chapter of the U.S. Green Building Council is committed to transforming the way buildings and communities are designed, built and operated in the greater Detroit region. The chapter relies on its hundreds of individual members, dedicated committees, a General Circle, Board of Directors, and sponsors to accomplish this goal.

WHO IS USGBC NATIONAL?

The USGBC is a nonprofit organization committed to a prosperous and sustainable future for our nation through cost-efficient and energy-saving green buildings. USGBC works toward its mission of market transformation through its LEED green building certification program, robust educational offerings, a nationwide network of chapters and affiliates, the annual Greenbuild International Conference & Expo, and advocacy in support of public policy that encourages and enables green buildings and communities.

WHAT IS LEED?

Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design, or LEED, is a voluntary, consensus-based national rating system for facilities and neighborhood developments that are designed, constructed, and operated for improved environmental and human health performance. LEED addresses all building types and emphasizes state-of-the-art strategies in five areas: sustainable site development, water savings, energy efficiency, materials and resources selection, and indoor environmental quality. Additionally, LEED for Neighborhood Development addresses cohesive, larger tracts of developed properties using three strategies: smart location and linkage, neighborhood pattern and design, and green infrastructure & buildings.

WHAT ARE LEED PROFESSIONAL CREDENTIALS?

LEED AP and LEED Green Associate designations recognize professionals who have demonstrated a thorough understanding of green building techniques, the LEED green building rating systems, and the certification process. The LEED Professional Credentials program is administered by the Green Building Certification Institute (GBCI), which was established with the support of USGBC to allow for objective, balanced management of the credential program. The USGBC Detroit Regional Chapter offers education programs for area professionals pursuing LEED AP or LEED Green Associate accreditation or credential maintenance. LEED AP areas of specialty include: Building Design + Construction, Interior Design + Construction, Homes, Neighborhood Development, and Operations + Maintenance.
