



Henry Lee, M.D. is a board-certified ophthalmologist with additional fellowship training in oculofacial plastic and reconstructive surgery. He specializes in cosmetic and non-cosmetic procedures involving the eyelids, the tear ducts, and the orbit/eye socket.

Dr. Lee is originally from New Jersey and received his medical degree from the Mount Sinai School of Medicine in New York City. He completed his residency at the University of Pennsylvania Scheie Eye Institute in Philadelphia. Dr. Lee then completed two additional years of subspecialty training in an American Society of Ophthalmic Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery (ASOPRS)-sponsored fellowship in Seattle, WA, where he gained much experience with minimally-invasive cosmetic procedures such as dermal fillers and Botox® injections. In a given year, there are only approximately 20 such fellowships available. Dr. Lee is working at MEA on a part-time basis in both the Doylestown, PA and the Hopewell, NJ offices.
