Name	Description	Application Information
<a href="#">Bill Dickey Scholarship</a>	Each year, BDSA awards scholarship grant and financial aid packages. Awards range from one-time grants of \$1,000 to four-years worth as much as \$3,500 annually. Awards are based on academic achievement, entrance exam scores, financial need, references, evidence of community service, and golfing ability.	Deadline - May 11, 2015
<a href="#">Caitlin Brondolo Golf Scholarship</a>	The objective of the Caitlin Brondolo Scholarship is to award a scholarship to a female high school senior who has played golf during high school and is pursuing a college education in the United States and who will be playing competitive collegiate golf.	Deadline - May 31, 2015
<a href="#">Chick Evans Caddie Scholarship</a>	Each year more than 200 new Caddie scholarships are awarded to college students who need financial aid. Students must have successfully caddied for at least 2 years and are expected to work at the sponsoring club during the summer while in the scholarship program	Deadline - October 31, 2015
<a href="#">Earl Woods Scholarship (EWS) Program for Minorities</a>	Offers tuition and other financial assistance to high school junior and seniors from select geographic regions or by invitation. Candidates must demonstrate academic achievement (with a minimum GPA of 3.0); a commitment to community service; and financial need to qualify for the EWSP.	N/A
<a href="#">Furman University Athletic Scholarships</a>	The Furman University Athletic Scholarships are partial to full scholarships awarded in 17 men's and women's intercollegiate sports.	N/A
<a href="#">GCSAA Essay Contest</a>	This program awards scholarships totaling \$4,500 to applicants who are undergraduate and graduate students pursuing degrees in turfgrass science, agronomy or any other field related to golf course management. Applicants must be GCSAA members. Click <a href="#">HERE</a> for information on how to join.	Deadline - March 15, 2015
<a href="#">GCSAA Legacy Awards</a>	Knowing the costs of higher education will continue to rise, the Environmental Institute for Golf developed this program to provide scholarship assistance to the children and grandchildren of GCSAA members who have been active Class A, Superintendent Members, Class C, Class A-Retired, Class B-Retired or Class AA members for five or more consecutive years. Honorees receive a \$1,500 award.	Deadline - April 15, 2015
<a href="#">GCSAA Scholars Competition</a>	These scholarships range from \$500 to \$6,000. Applicants must be enrolled in a recognized undergraduate program in a major field related to turf management, have completed at least 24 credit hours or the equivalent of one year of full-time study in the appropriate major, and be a member of GCSAA. Wood Platt Caddie Scholarship</a>	The scholarship program is <b>open to young persons who have caddied for at least one year at one or more Member Clubs of the Golf Association of Philadelphia</b> . Additionally, they must have good academic qualifications and be in need of financial aid to meet college expenses.	Deadline - May 15, 2015
<a href="#">New Jersey State Golf Association Caddie Scholarship</a>	The New Jersey State Golf Association (NJSGA) Caddie Scholarship is available to qualified applicants who have caddied at a member NJSGA club for at least two seasons. Full-time attendance as an undergraduate at an accredited institution that is a member of the Association of American Colleges and Universities is required. Children of private golf club members are not eligible for scholarships.	Deadline - March 1, 2015
<a href="#">The AT&amp;T Pebble Beach Junior Golf Association Scholarship</a>	This association awards several scholarships each year to students who graduate from high school and who expect to enroll in a four-year college program that same year.	N/A
<a href="#">The Dinah Shore Scholarship</a>	This scholarship is administered by the LPGA Foundation and will be given to a female high school senior who played golf during high school, but will not be playing collegiate golf.	Deadline - May 15, 2015
<a href="#">The First Tee Home Office Staff Scholarship Fund</a>	The <i>"Home Office Scholarship Fund"</i> was created to provide a scholarship to participants to help fund their educational needs after high school. <a href="#">The First Tee Scholars Program</a>	The Scholars Program is a distinction awarded to participants who excel in academics, leadership, character development, and chapter and community involvement.	Deadline - November 2015
<a href="#">The Francis Ouimet Scholarship Fund</a>	All Ouimet Scholarship candidates must have performed at least two years service to golf as caddies, or in golf professional or course superintendent operations at any golf course in Massachusetts.	Deadline - December 2015
<a href="#">The Marilyn Smith Scholarship</a>	This scholarship is administered by the LPGA Foundation and will be awarded to ten high school seniors who will be playing golf at the collegiate level.	Deadline - May 15, 2015
<a href="#">The Phyllis G. Meekins Scholarship</a>	This scholarship is administered by the LPGA Foundation and is a need-based award to a high school senior from a recognized minority background who will be playing golf at the collegiate level. Qualifications for all scholarships include strong academic programs, community service and recommendations.	Deadline - May 15, 2015

<a href="#">Walter Byers Postgraduate Scholarship Program</a>	Under this program, one male and one female student-athlete annually will be awarded a postgraduate scholarship in recognition of outstanding academic achievement and potential for success in postgraduate study. Applications are by nomination only.	Deadline - January 31, 2015
<a href="#">Webber International University Athletic Scholarship</a>	The Athletic Scholarship is awarded at the discretion of the athletic department in football, basketball, tennis, volleyball, soccer, golf, softball, cross country, baseball, track and field and cheerleading.	N/A
<a href="#">Western Colorado Golf Foundation</a>	The <b>student must be a graduating senior from a public or private school located on the Western Slope of Colorado</b> (as defined by the Colorado Golf Association) and admitted to an accredited college or university on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 credit hours).	Deadline - March 1, 2015
<a href="#">William Woods University Athletic Scholarships</a>	Students who demonstrate talent and skills in the areas of women's basketball, golf, softball, soccer, or volleyball and men's baseball, golf, soccer or volleyball may apply for this award.	N/A
<a href="#">Women's Western Golf Foundation Scholarship</a>	Award winners receive a grant in the amount of \$8,000 over four years. Two thousand dollars (\$2,000) per year is applied toward tuition, room & board, and other university fees or charges. Money is sent directly to the University. Candidates will be selected on the basis of academic achievement, financial need, excellence of character, and an involvement in the sport of golf. Skill or excellence in the sport of golf is not a criterion.	Deadline - March 1, 2015
