GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSIONS

DEADLINE: Sunday evening for the upcoming Tuesday issue; email to tarheelscouter@gmail.com. Identify your unit (Pack, Troop or Crew) by number, district, location and chartering organization. Include a contact phone number (in case we need to reach you with any questions).

The text of your article or announcement can be either in the body of your email or as an attached Word document (not a PDF). Photos should be attached as JPEG files (larger resolution files are better, so they can be cropped and enlarged). Please provide a caption for each photo: identify people in photos (left to right, first row, second row) and describe what is happening in the photo.

When writing an article/announcement, remember the 5 W's - Who, What, Where, When and Why? Photos are very important in making a story interesting. Consider asking someone in your unit to “Be Prepared” to take photos at your events. Ask someone who is excited about Scouting to write up the details of your event. In addition to describing the action, get quotes/insights from Scouts, parents or those attending. Quotes personalize the experience and make the event even more interesting.
