Learn how to enhance trust, leadership and guidance with youth and how to translate federal mandates into actions that will help youth.

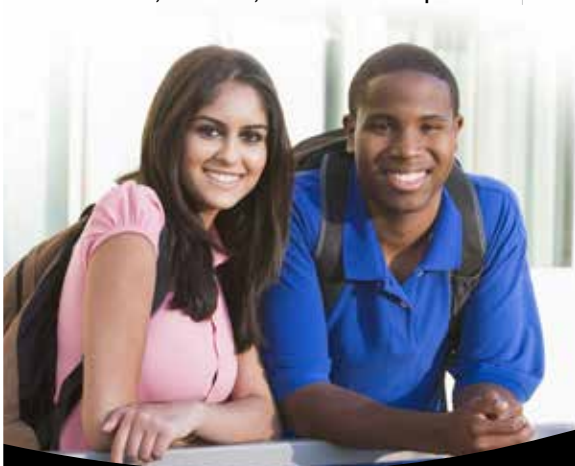
