GRANT PROCESS WINTER 2015

This year the PTA is dedicated to **Making More Happen** at Greenwood Elementary. In order for us to be successful, we need your ideas and requests for investment back into our school. Let us know what you think would benefit GW by applying for a PTA Grant!

What are PTA Grants?

PTA grants are a way for the GW PTA to help meet the varied needs identified by our most important constituents. Grants may be requested for an individual classroom or for items or projects that benefit a range of classrooms or ages. The evaluation criteria give priority to funding requests that:

- Serve students in an entire grade level or more
- Increase the variety of curriculum enhancement options available to students—those opportunities that make Greenwood special.
- Can be reused by other groups at Greenwood.
- Are unlikely to be funded by another source in a reasonable timeframe.

What is the Evaluation Process?

A Grant Committee comprised of 4 PTA parent members and 3 Greenwood teachers and/or staff, will collect the applications and review them according to the criteria. Principal Brad Gustafson and the PTA President and Treasurer will consult with the committee, but are not voting participants. All proposals will be carefully considered, although it may not be possible to fund all requests.

What kinds of requests are approved?

In the past few years the Grant Process has funded a range of requests. Examples from the past couple of years include: classroom furniture, books, musical instruments, document cameras, playground equipment, die-cut machine and tools, special education equipment and Partners in Art curriculum. If you have identified a need, don't hesitate to fill out a request form. If you have an idea that may need further research, let me know as we have folks that are willing to help pull together the requests.

Who Can Apply?

Any Greenwood teacher, staff or PTA Member is invited to complete an application. Please note, Grant Committee members are not allowed to be a **Primary Applicant** this year.

Grant Application deadline: Friday, February 28, 2015.
