In order to qualify for a scholarship provided from the Alpharetta Rotary, a student must:

- A. Be a citizen or a legal resident of the United States, a resident of the state of Georgia, a resident of Alpharetta or Milton, GA, OR sponsored by a member of the Alpharetta Rotary Club. Children and grandchildren of members of the Alpharetta Rotary are ineligible;
- B. Be planning to attend a technical school, college or university; scholarship funds will be sent directly to the institution the student chooses to attend upon proof of enrollment.
- C. Be a well-rounded community member who exhibits leadership and strong character.
- D. Exhibit achievement in academics, school and community activities, and/or employment.
- E. Have a GPA of at least 3.0.
- F. Demonstrate in a letter of 500 words or less, a record of "service above self" in the community past and present, and how this scholarship will benefit the applicant and his/her future educational plans.
- G. Provide one letter of recommendation from a teacher, supervisor, church leader, community service mentor, or Rotarian sponsor will be considered by the scholarship committee.
