Join the Nakba Education Project in welcoming speakers from BADIL and Zochrot for a discussion on the ongoing Nakba affecting Palestinians both in Palestine and in the diaspora.

Presentations will aim to provide a historical overview of the Nakba ("Catastrophe" in Arabic) and the Right of Return, the forcible displacement of Palestinians since before 1948 and continuing today, and the practicalities of return for refugees.

In turn, American audiences will have focused time to consider their role in supporting the call for the Right of Return and how to integrate the Nakba into U.S.-based activism.
