

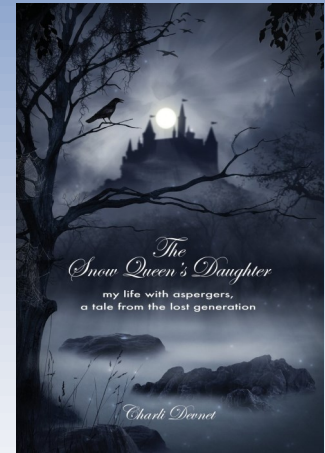

about growing up in the 1960s with undiagnosed Asperger Syndrome. This free program is presented in conjunction with Concordia's Teacher Education Program.



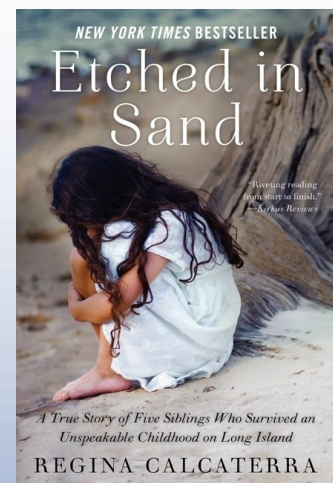
