Maryland & Montgomery County Historic Preservation Tax Credits Workshop

You may qualify for tax credits on expenditures for restoration and maintenance work. Come find out more about the Maryland Sustainable Communities Tax Credit program.

Join staff from the Maryland Historical Trust, Montgomery County Planning Department, and the City of Rockville on <u>Tuesday, February 24 from 7 pm to 9 pm at the Red Brick</u> <u>Courthouse</u> to learn how you can apply for tax credits for renovation work. Featuring presentations by Melissa Archer of MHT, Historic Preservation Supervisor Scott Whipple of the Montgomery Planning Department, and City of Rockville Historic Preservation Planner Sheila Bashiri.

The Maryland Sustainable Communities Tax Credit program offers financial incentives for renovating or rehabilitating historic buildings. It has now expanded to help owners of small businesses in designated Sustainable Communities, including Rockville, repair and improve their historic structures.

This free workshop will provide an overview of the expansion of the state tax credit and how to apply. It will also cover the state homeowner tax credit, which can be bundled with Montgomery County tax credits.

Restoration work on the Rose Hill Barn in Rockville was offset by local tax credits in 2014.
