About CMAA Foundation Chapter Internships

The CMAA NCC, a 501(c)3 charitable organization awards a limited number of internships to qualified applicants to promote experience and career growth opportunities to students pursuing a degree in Construction Management or a related-degree program. The internships are awarded by the local National Capital Chapter and students will gain summer employment in a Construction Management related field with one of the NCC corporate sponsors in the Washington, DC metropolitan area. Applicants are eligible for a grand total of two (2) summer internships awarded by CMAA throughout their academic career.

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. Must have completed a minimum of one full academic year of studies, and must have a minimum of one full academic year remaining prior to completing the degree being pursued.
- 2. Must be enrolled in a Construction Management degree program, or other CM-related degree program, and show a strong interest in a career in CM, as demonstrated by a response to the essay and/or interview questions in the application package.
- Internship candidates must be either United States citizens or be authorized to work in the United States.

NOTE: Incomplete applications will not be considered by the CMAA National Capital Chapter Internship selection committee. The application and all associated attachments must be submitted via mail or email.

CMAA National Capital Chapter Internship Application Process

Simply complete the Internship application, making sure to refer to the application directions, and return it to the National Capital Chapter by March 13, 2015. CMAA National Capital Chapter Internship Review Process

- The CMAA National Capital Chapter Internship selection committee will review all complete applications received from direct submittals, and make its decision based on the received application. Selected Internship finalists will be notified in March 2015.
- 2. Internship finalists are required to interview with their sponsoring company as final step of the selection process.

The CMAA National Capital Chapter Internship selection committee will consider the following in selecting winners of the chapter scholarships and internships:

- academic performance
- quality of interview questions
- previous work experience
- extracurricular activities
- references (if provided)

 application submitted missing any of the sections and without a signature will be disqualified from
 consideration.
- The response to the essay and/or interview questions must be typed. Be sure to check spelling and grammar carefully; presentation is important.
- Please keep a copy of your complete application package. The returned proof of delivery will serve as verification that your application has been received. No additional notification will be provided.
