- Old Roof/Furnace /Plumbing /Electrical at or near the end of its service life end; requiring expensive repairs.
- Holes /Cracks in the building envelope or foundation; disguised or hidden from view.

- Flooding Frequent water backup or flooding events in the past; evidence hidden by new drywall.
- Oil Tanks abandoned and very expensive to remove along with soil-remediation.
- Moisture Wet basements or crawl spaces damaging to the home and unhealthy.
- Fire Damage Compromised homes which can stink of smoke for decades and /or are unsafe.
- No Permits Major work done with no oversight; potential for BIG and expensive problems.
