# The Objective:

The Chamber's Annual Citizen of the Year Award recognizes the volunteer contributions of Members of the business community in Salem County. The award is given annually to an individual or group who has demonstrated a high level of service through community and civic involvement in Salem County NJ.

#### Criteria:

An individual in the Salem County business community who has consistently demonstrated excellence in community leadership over an extended period of time.

- Must have lived or worked in Salem County for at least 3 years.
- Has made or is making significant contributions to the welfare of the community through involvement and participation in endeavors that enhance the quality of life in Salem County.
- Dedicated service to the citizenry of Salem County and it's business community through consistent support of Chamber events and activities.
- The award may be presented to any Chamber Member/Retired Member whose volunteer work has been focused inside Salem County. The work must be volunteer only.

Nomination must be accompanied by a Citizen of the Year Nomination Form

#### **Guidelines:**

Must be a current Member in good standing or Retired Member of the Salem County Chamber of Commerce

- Individual may not nominate self
- May be eligible to win the award once

Members of the Committee are not eligible to win the award.

#### The Decision Making Process:

The final decision for Citizen of the Year is determined by The Chamber Executive Committee and kept strictly confidential until the winner is announced at the culmination of the Annual Banquet, April 16, 2015.


