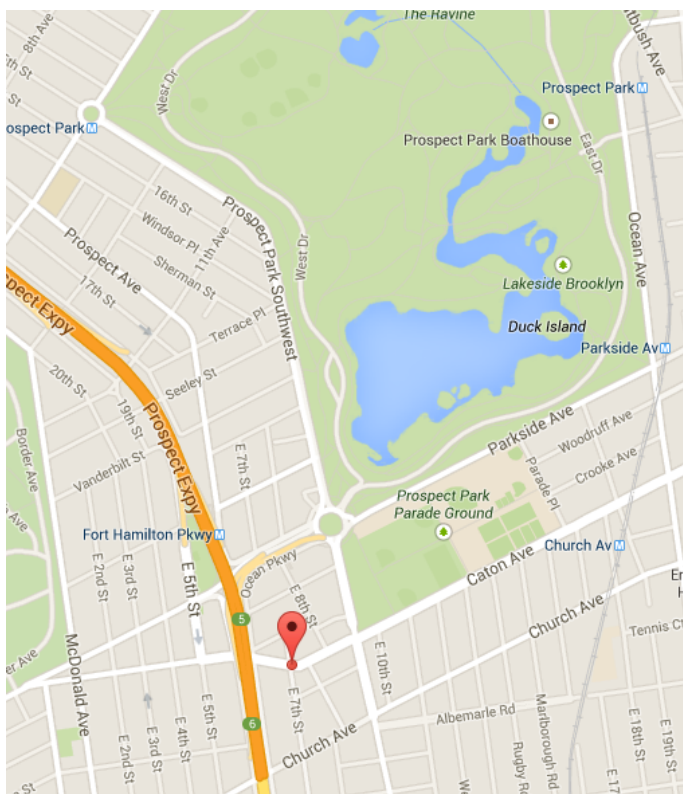


Who can apply? All current 5th grade students who attend school or reside in District 15 can apply.

How can I apply? Apply by requesting a New Middle School application from your elementary school and selecting M.S. 839. The new middle school application process is separate from the main round application, so if you receive an offer to M.S. 839, you will still have your main round middle school offer and can choose between your two offers!
