

What Is Commissioner Tools?

Commissioner Tools is a new tool available on the new my. Scouting Tools for many Councils. It's intended to help Commissioners better perform (not change) current functions by improving efficiency and easy access of information. A few examples of what can be done in Commissioner Tools:

- Assign commissioners to units.
- Record contacts. A commissioner is most effective through frequent contact with their units so they can build a friendly and trusting relationship.
- Roundtable administrations. Plan, record attendance, and monitor effectiveness.
- Conduct assessments to help a unit improve. In concert with the
 Unit Service Plan and Journey to Excellence (JTE), the tool provides
 the ability to record the results and build action plans that may access
 and incorporate district, council, and other resources beyond the unit.
- Monitor a unit's progress. Access unit information.

Not all functionality will be available in the initial release of Commissioner Tools, and BSA will continue to add enhancements based upon your input.
