The loose offering on this Sunday goes into a fund that helps to pay for emergencies that may arise for any parishioner, or a need that may need to be addressed. 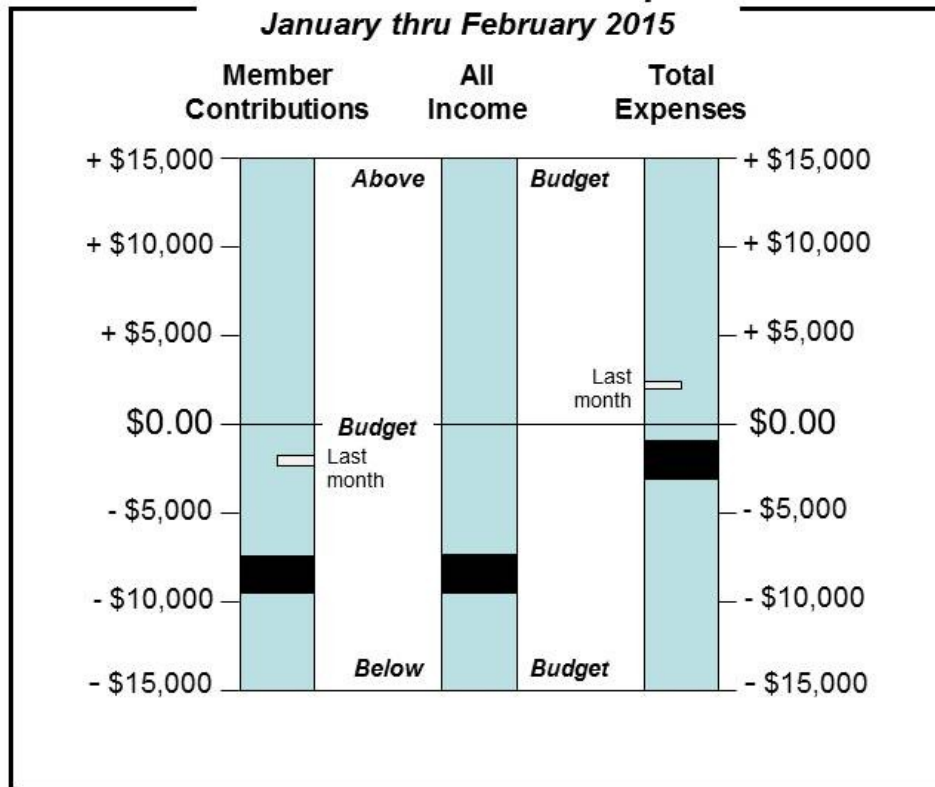
