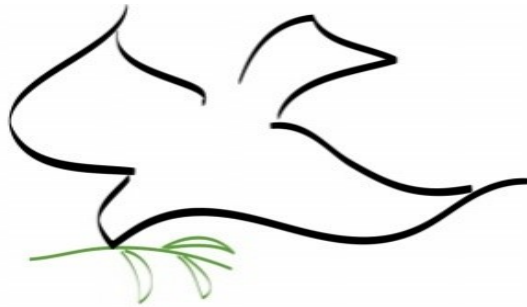

THE ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE

Tomorrow comes quickly. The summer is slipping away. The start of school is here or is just around the corner. This early start seems very strange to grandparents of my generation.

Although it seems like months away, the thoughts of the members of the administration committee are already starting to focus on developing a list of "Nominees" for the 2017 Vestry elections. This undertaking is a responsibility of all members of the congregation.



Vestry Nomination Information

It behooves all of us in our church community to be familiar with the ASEC By-laws in order to intelligently participate in church activities. We will investigate placing a copy of the bylaws on our website — allsaintsdi-oet.org. In the meantime copies are available in the church office. Equally important are access to the Constitution and Canons for the Episcopal Diocese of East Tennessee. These can be found at etiocese.net under the drop-down menu labeled Resources. Actions of the Episcopal Church (USA) are also available through that site.

Excerpts and Comments Regarding the First Part of The "ASEC By-laws Diocese of East Tennessee"

ASEC and the vestry operate under bylaws adopted November 2010. These "By-laws" are reviewed periodically by the Administrative Committee. If anything in the "By-laws" is contrary to the Constitution and Canons of the Episcopal Church (USA) or of the Episcopal Diocese of East Tennessee the "By-laws" of All Saints Episcopal Church are superseded by same.

ASEC is a 501 C3, nonprofit corporation under the Tennessee Corporation Act. As a nonprofit C3 corporation certain activities are restrained. The Parish constitutes the Corporation, and the Vestry constitutes the Board of Directors. Per national Canons the Vestry shall be agent and legal representative of the Parish.

- "Nominee" is a communicant in good standing, nominated by members of the Parish as a candidate for Vestry but who has not yet agreed to have his/her name on the ballot.
- "Candidate" is a nominee who has agreed to stand for election to the Vestry and whose name shall appear on the ballot for election to the Vestry at the upcoming Annual Meeting.
- "Communicant in Good Standing" is defined by the Constitution and Canons of the Episcopal Church (USA).
- "Communicant" identifies a person who has become a member of the parish and who has received Holy Communion at least three times during the preceding year.
- "In Good Standing" indicates additional faithfulness and regular attendance, working and praying for the spread of the Kingdom of God in providing financial support of the church through pledging.
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Article III — Elections Process for Vestry Membership .

Sec. 1 Qualification to Serve — To be eligible to serve on the Vestry of this parish, candidates for election shall be Adult Communicants in Good Standing for the prior year as defined by Church Canons. Members 16 years of age and over are to be considered adult members and may otherwise qualify as a communicant in good standing.

This committee continues its work on a review and update of the Policies & Procedures.

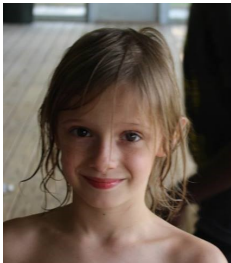
Noah's Arc expressed their appreciation for the food and bedding given to them and a fall food and bedding drive is planned for October.
