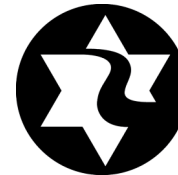

Marc was raised in Millersville, Pennsylvania, attended Penn Manor High School and is the son of a high school teacher. Pursuing his belief in service above self, Marc graduated from the United States Military Academy at West Point in 1986, and served as an Army Captain and an aviator. As a scout pilot, Marc was fortunate to witness the fall of the Iron Curtain first-hand while serving in the famed 11<sup>th</sup> Armor Cavalry Regiment in Fulda, West Germany.

Marc later graduated with a law degree from the Northwestern University School of Law and began practicing as a litigator in 1995. His legal practice focused primarily on representing healthcare providers, including physicians, nurses, hospitals, and nursing homes in professional liability and licensure matters. Marc’s law practice also included automobile liability, insurance bad faith, and premises liability. Marc recently returned to public service and currently serves as a Hearing Examiner for the Pennsylvania Department of State where he presides over hearings involving licensure disciplinary actions and administrative appeals.

Marc and his family moved to Derry Township in 2003. Motivated to give back to his community, he was recently elected to a second term on the Derry Township Board of Supervisors in 2015. Marc has successfully promoted financial accountability for Derry Township and has worked to pass five responsible budgets that held the line on taxes. He has also been instrumental in the expansion of the Township's walking and biking trails and has consistently championed responsible growth and development.

Marc is a member of the Hershey Rotary Club, Hershey-Derry Township Historical Society, Friends of the Hershey Public Library, and the Trojan Foundation. As the Vice-Chairman of the Derry Township Board of Supervisors, Marc also serves on the Derry Township Parks and Recreation Board, Library Board of Directors, and the Derry Township Police Pension Advisory Board. Marc is also Chairman of the Derry Township General Authority and he serves as the Board of Supervisors’ liaison with the Derry Township School Board.

Marc is married to Susan Moyer, an Assistant District Attorney in the Lancaster County District Attorney’s Office. The couple has a daughter and enjoy bike-riding, hiking and snorkeling, and travelling together. Marc also enjoys running and is an avid golfer (which he finds to be very challenging!).
