The Lois B. Young Scholarship is administered by the Folsom Chamber of Commerce and FLYP, Folsom's Leading Young Professionals. The Lois B. Young Scholarship was established to honor the memory and service of Lois B. Young.

At least one scholarship will be awarded to a student who will attend a community college in the Fall 2015 and one scholarship will be awarded to a student who will attend a four year university. Scholarship awards are typically \$500.

- Minimum 2.5 GPA
- · Clear focus on extracurricular or volunteer work
- · Desire to remain in or return to the local community.
- · Additional consideration will be given to candidates with demonstrated financial need.

Required:

- Completed application
- A current resume. This can include clubs, sports, employment and/or volunteer work.
- 1 letter of recommendation (from a teacher, coach or school administrator, church leader, volunteer/community service coordinator who has observed your work)
