

## Cookie Booth Etiquette Guidelines

Make your cookie booth sale a great experience for girls and for the business or organization that hosts you!

First of all, remember: your host venue has given you the privilege of using the facility. Show your respect and good manners by following these guidelines:

- Set up your booth sale in the area designated by the host, not in any other areas.
- Do not complain about any of the rules set and follow them.
- Do not block the entrance and only approach customers as they are leaving the venue.
- Be identifiable as Girl Scouts; wear your Girl Scout Membership pin, uniform, or other Girl Scout clothing; and have a neat, clean appearance.
- Adults must present with the girls at all times and should help resolve any conflicts peacefully and quietly.
- Bring change with you and do not ask others at the venue for change.
- Maintain a positive attitude, smile; say thank you even if a customer does not buy.
- Bring your own table and hang signs on it, not on the venue's property.
- Clean up after your booth sale and take your trash with you.
- Park away from the front of the business; do not take up good parking spaces.
- Notify the venue if you need to cancel.
- Thank venue managers/staff for permitting you to hold your cookie booth on their premises.
