CSA, or community supported agriculture, is a partnership of mutual commitment between a farm and a community of supporters – CSA members make a commitment to support the farm throughout the season, assuming the risks and bounty of growing food along with the farmer. The farm provides, to the best of its ability, a healthy supply of seasonal fresh produce throughout the growing season. CSA promotes a responsible relationship between people and the food they eat, the land on which it is grown, and those who grow it.

Your Share

Delivered box shares will contain 8-10 different types of fresh vegetables from the farm and are designed to feed 2-3 adults or a small family each week. We grow a wide variety of vegetables on the farm using organic methods. You are always welcome to visit the farm and harvest pick your own crops as available during the season.

Share Lengths:

- * **Full season shares** start the first week in June and end the last week in October
- * **Summer shares** start the first week in June and end the last week in August.
- * **Fall shares** start the first week in September and end the last week in October
