We are also close to putting out for bid, lift station plans which will serve the southeast part of our city, which includes 114 acres east of 33 Highway that was recently annexed into the city. We have also initiated a downtown flower project which is also paid for mostly by donation.

In my role as mayor, I have worked to build better relationships within the county. I have also been privileged to be asked to speak to the Wellsville third grade classes each year, where I tell them about the history of the city and also about city government.

My vision for our community includes moderate residential, retail and economic growth, continued infrastructure improvements, expanded retail opportunities and a commitment to strive to see that our community continues to be a great place to live and raise a family.
