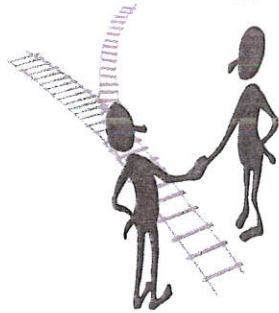

Team: Groups or individuals who join in the effort to clean up a community (associations + schools + residents = Team)

Cleanup Campaigns: An official with the Mobile County Commission Department of Environmental Enforcement will contact prospective groups to schedule a date for the campaign. A central location for collecting trash should be chosen to serve as an intermediate dump site. Mobile County reserves the right to approve all dump sites chosen. County workers will carry collected trash to county landfills throughout scheduled clean up day.

Rules:

- Each team must designate a team captain to coordinate the clean up.
- Team captains are responsible for notifying volunteers of dates/times
- Clean ups will begin no earlier than 8:00 a.m. Start items are flexible, but should be in the morning hours.
- Trash will not be accepted after the designated ending time.
- Some items are unacceptable for trash pickup.
- Authorized volunteers will receive paraphernalia – provided by the Mobile County Commission.
- Mobile County will provide trash bags, trash removal equipment and a work crew.
- Mobile County will not be liable for injuries or accidents that occur during a clean-up campaign.

The Following Items Will Not Be Accepted During a Clean Up Campaign

- Waste oil or oil filters
- Junk cars or car parts
- Dead animals
- Pressure tanks of any kind (gas, butane, etc.)
- Explosives of any kind (old shot guns or shell guns, etc.)
- Aerosol cans
- Household garbage
- Tires without rims
- TVs
- Computer Monitors
