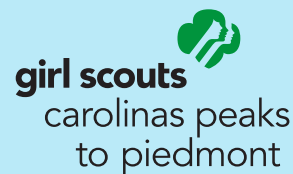

My Promise My Faith

Being a Girl Scout today means being a part of a worldwide organization that builds leadership skills by providing girls with opportunities to discover their interests, connect with others, and take action to change the world for the better. During Girl Scout Week, Girl Scouts of all ages celebrate by demonstrating leadership and commitment in ways that have a real impact on their communities.

Everything in Girl Scouting is based on the Girl Scout Promise and Law. The Girl Scout Law includes many of the principles and values common to most faiths. Thus, while a secular organization, Girl Scouts has encouraged girls to take spiritual journeys via their faiths' religious recognitions since our movement began.

Girls of all grade levels can earn the My Promise, My Faith pin, which complements existing religious recognitions and allows all girls to further strengthen the connection between their faith and Girl Scouts. A girl earns the My Promise, My Faith pin by carefully examining the Girl Scout Law and directly tying it to tenets of her faith.

Or, girls can earn a P.R.A.Y. – Programs of Religious Activities with Youth – religious award. The P.R.A.Y. program helps girls to develop a deeper relationship with God and to understand how God is active in their lives and in the world around them.
