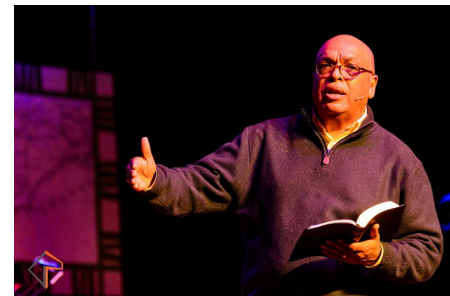


Encounter: "Follow Me"

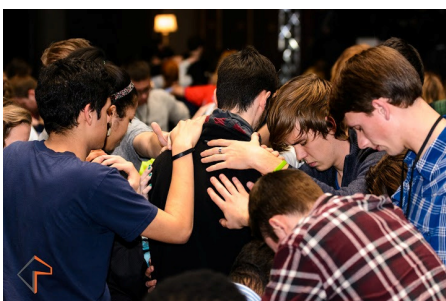
Amazing speakers throughout the week both in large group sessions and also in seminars that students could choose based on their specific needs and desires for growth.
