

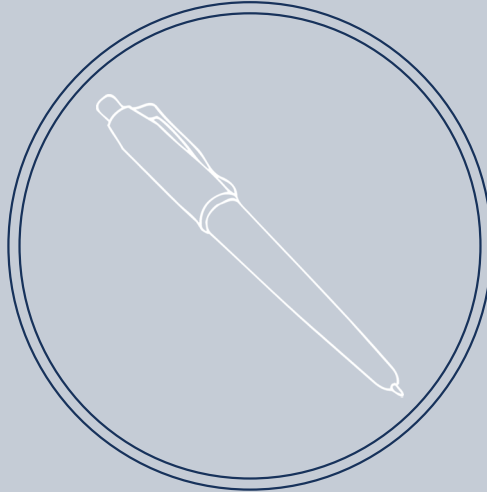
LIFT THE BAN
